ACTIVE PRAYER IS THE ONLY PRAYER GOD HEARS

Prayer is not a passive act; it is an active engagement with the spiritual realm. It is a constant reminder that we are not alone in our struggles. How to create a war room

1. War Room (Spiritual Base)

To create your own war room for prayer, start by finding a dedicated space in your home. A small space that is free from distractions. It is a quiet and secluded area where you can give God your undivided attention. Clear out any clutter and create a peaceful atmosphere including cell phones. Set up a comfortable chair or cushion for sitting. Ex. Closet, dining room, guest bed room etc.

2. Your weapon (The Bible)

The Bible is a powerful weapon in the hands of believers. Through the guidance of the Holy Spirit, it leads us to the word of God, providing us with spiritual nourishment and guidance.

3. Your mission (prayer)

In order to experience the presence of the Holy Spirit, it is important to have a clear mind and an open heart. By stilling our thoughts, we create space for the Holy Spirit to come upon us. It is reassuring to know that we do not need to worry about what we need to say, as the Holy Spirit will provide us with the words in that very moment. Finally, establish a routine for prayer, whether it's daily or weekly, and commit to spending intentional time in your war room.
